SOIL & WATER MANAGEMENT: Basic properties of soils, drainage and water movement, soil conservation, tillage, management of salinity & sodium, soil & water quality, irrigation system design & operation, plant water requirements.

INTEGRATED PEST MANGEMENT: IPM principles & practices, pest characteristics, pest management alternatives, safety/regulatory aspects, pesticide stewardship.

CROP MANAGEMENT: Crop adaptation, seedbed preparation & planting, crop damage, replanting decisions, variety selection, crop rotations/systems, seed technology, pruning, trellis systems.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT: Ethics training, computer courses, business courses, economic seminars, legislative and policy related training, and communications.

MANURE MANAGEMENT: Manure properties and production, manure collection, storage, and treatment, manure sampling and analysis, crop availability and behavior of manure-derived nutrients in soil, nutrient balance, manure application, regulations and cost-share programs, manure impacts on water quality, air quality, and animal production.
